Closing Meal Chants (do Buddhist or Shambhala, whichever you opened the meal with)

Buddhist

By this merit, may all obtain omniscience, May it defeat the enemy wrong-doing, From the storm waves of birth, old-age, sickness and death, From the ocean of samsara may I free all beings.

Shambhala

By the confidence of the Golden Sun of the Great East, May the lotus garden of the Rigden's wisdom bloom. May the dark ignorance of sentient beings be dispelled, May all beings enjoy profound, brilliant glory.
